Club Positions 2019/20

We have sent out an email of all the adult roles / positions that combine to make our Nippers great. Please take your time to review the positions and talk to your family about what you think you would be capable and willing to do next year. Please understand if you are thinking that you would like your nipper/s to attend the free beach and surf training and have the club pay your nippers carnival entry fee, one parent or quardian must hold one of the positions. An under 14 or older sibling that actively does water safety is acceptable. No one expects you to be President but getting your age manager, water safety, IRB or official qualification is easy and expected. You aren't automatically doing every Sunday or carnival as we will share the responsibility over all the parents evenly. By 2020, one parent or sibling will need to hold a position or we won't be able to enter your Nippers in the great 2020 branch or state carnival.
