Hi everyone and welcome to another Grape-vine.

After a long process due to unforeseen circumstances (including closed beaches and unavailability of outside assessors) we managed to finalise the majority of the last Bronze / SRC Course. We still have two very patient members waiting for their final assessment. Thank you to everyone who was involved in these courses.

Please contact the office ASAP if you are a proficient bronze holder and would like to do your IRB Crew award or if you are 17 years and over and hold your Bronze and IRB Crew certificate and are interested in doing the IRB Drivers course.

We need to have a list of names before we can apply to run the courses.

IRB STUFF.

Good grief, plenty to report regarding IRB,s, none of it particularly positive either.

All four Outboard Motors had a thorough service performed on them a week ago. Upon inspection by the Mechanic it was found that one motor had the "flush out bolt" removed for engine flush out but was not refitted. This was later found sitting on a plastic bin in the shed. Had the engine been run without this bolt fitted it would have overheated and seized because the water pump impeller would not operate in the absence of this bolt. Fortunately it was discovered in time. The bottom line is do not remove this bolt under any circumstances, use the water tank for flushing the engines after use.

Also we are not using the "Rabbit Ears" flush system any more as on far too many occasions the ears have been left on the motor. The last occasion was a couple of weeks ago where the ears were left on and the motor was started and attempted to run. The driver was wondering why the motor would not accelerate. The noise it would have made should have been a big give away as the propeller mangled the rabbit ears , deeply gouging the prop guard. Fortunately the rubber bushing in the propeller must have slipped and this saved the motor from major damage. Once again, use the water bin to flush out the engines.

Accidents happen, like a rollover, please report this and note in the IRB log of operations. on this occasion this was not done.

The book now indicates that you only have to run the motor for one hour after a submersion to remove salt remnants so please follow the restart procedures as per your training and spray with plenty of WD40. WD40 is applied with the pump bottle on the shelf, with back up in a 4 Ltr container above the fuel cabinet. We no longer use the spray cans.

Speaking of the IRB log of operations, I went through all the entries for quite a few months and noted very few entries of faults, even though I knew of them and the motors tagged. Please put in the relevant information regarding problems so as appropriate action can be taken . Good example of this was last weekend the tilt lock pin was broken on one of the motors. Newly qualified IRB Driver Sharon Leaney wrote a comprehensive report in the log which provided me with all the information i required and what corrective action she took regarding this. Good work Sharon. I am ordering a new tilt lock pin.

The most common problem we are having with the motors is due to the wet weather and humidity the Carburetor butterfly chokes are seizing up. Attempting to start an engine in this state results in flooding of the motor. If the choke lever does not operate, please do not force it as you will bend the shaft, resulting in the Carburetor being unserviceable as parts are not available. Please report the fault and I will fix it.

Could all IRB drivers and crew please pay closer attention to pre-operational and postoperational checks. If you have youngsters helping you that are not trained as crew or driver please oversight them as their enthusiasm could sometimes exceed their ability and things could be missed..

That's it for now,, take care everyone.

APPROACHING THE FINISH LINE!

February was a very busy month for all things Nippers, with carnivals being rescheduled due to inclement surf and weather conditions. There were many adaptations required – dates, venues programs and timeframes for events and some flexibility around team changes based on this – and the Nipper Committee thanks everyone involved for helping facilitate these changes as smoothly as possible. There have been some very gentle conditions on a few of the Nipper Sundays, providing for a more relaxed water safety environment, and allowing the kids to spend a lot of time in the smaller surf on the boards. It's less than 2 weeks to the finale of the State Youth Champs at North Kirra on 12-14th March, where our Nippers race against the best in Queensland. Nipper Presentation day is on Sunday 21st March, where we give thanks to our volunteers, celebrate the achievements of the Nippers in their respective age groups for points accumulated throughout the season, provide awards for effort/attitude, good sports and encouragement, acknowledge our major awards of overall club champion, the Russ Freeman award, the Keiran Young Memorial relay winners and Tadpole to Patrol (9 years of Nippers for a few of our u14's who display longevity and the love of the sport to go the distance).

PDB BRANCH CHAMPS u11-14 ON 6TH AND 13TH FEB 2021

Split over 2 weekends and 2 clubs, North Kirra for the beach events and Tugun for the water event, this change brought its own challenges but allowed many people to watch more racing rather than moving constantly between different arenas. TH&C finished in 4th place overall, with 265 points, behind Tugun (544 pts), Currumbin (508 pts) and Tallebudgera (279 pts) and again the club is solid in points scored on the sand. This is an improvement from TH&C's 2019-20 to-tal 176 points, with an increase in the water points gained from last year, so well done kids and coaches.

- Errol Wright turned the Big 80 Congrats to All !


