

## **Tweed Heads & Coolangatta SLSC Policy 01**

### **STORAGE OF PERSONAL CRAFT**

#### **Background:**

Storage of craft in the racks available at TH&C SLSC has long been a privilege for Club members. As the number of competitors increase, there is a growing need for craft storage for those members who train regularly at the Club.

#### **Objective:**

This procedure aims to assist in the determination of fair and equitable craft storage at TH&C SLSC and to provide guidelines for the approval of craft storage.

NOTE: Priority will be given to the storage of club equipment and craft for coaches who need their craft to conduct training sessions.

#### **Priority for craft storage will be determined on how many of the items below members achieve:**

1. Financial, proficient members with Tweed Heads & Coolangatta SLSC. (*compulsory*)
2. Completion of Club commitments i.e.
  - a. Completed patrol obligations to the satisfaction of their Patrol Captain and the Club Captain (e.g.have arranged a swap or a substitute if they are unable to attend patrol) (*compulsory*)
  - b. Completion of fundraising commitments to the satisfaction of the Surf Sports Director. (*compulsory*)
3. Competition rights at TH&C SLSC
4. Number of craft training sessions attended each week.
5. Competitor who has met with Head Coach to assess goals for the current season.
6. Commitment to compete at Branch, States and Aussies for TH&C SLSC
7. Senior medal winner at Branch, States or Aussies in the previous season
8. If there are any remaining racks these may be allocated to Life Members/Management Committee Members.

#### **Application and approval of personal craft storage**

A craft storage application is to be completed and presented to the Surf Sports Committee for consideration
