FROM THE PRESIDENT

Hello Members

The current border restrictions are playing havor in the lives of our membership group with divided families, work challenges and our social interaction with friendship groups.

I am writing to confirm what these current restrictions mean to us as a surf club and some best case / worst case scenarios for season 2021-2022.

Right now we are relying on a few decisions to be made a little further up the chain. SLSQ are taking up the fight on behalf of all clubs but particularly the three southern clubs to have our branches 457 NSW patrolling members and our 500 Nippers allowed to travel across the border. This may also need us to meet the current guidelines of having had the first jab for patrol members.

Secondly the lockdown in Regional NSW is scheduled for review on 10/9. If this lockdown is released then we will be requiring the border bubble to be reinstated for us to all be able to get back to a season unchanged. This is the best case scenario.

Our season is scheduled to start from a patrol point of view on 18/9 so our timeline is tight.

Best case scenario is as above and a bubble is formed between 10/9 and 18/9 and our season commences and we all get to hang out as one club.

The next scenario is the northern NSW lock-down is lifted but no bubble in place will result in our Nippers being run on both sides of the border.

Point Danger Branch will be offering Sunday Nippers at Jack Evans boat harbour for all members of clubs within our branch. Failing this THC will be doing their own Nipper program at Jack Evans boat harbour for our NSW members.

ONE WAY OR ANOTHER WE WILL BE RUNNING NIPPERS unless lockdown is extended.

From a patrol point of view we are working on the above scenario thinking that patrol members may be able to cross but not Nippers.

As soon as restrictions lift further we would then return back to normal at Greenmount Beach.

In the meantime we are waiting on the NSW lockdown to lift so that we can do pool swims to start the season. After 10/9 and subject to it lifting we will then arrange pool swim days for all of our NSW members. Qld members should be proceeding as normal with your pool swim sign off and online membership so you are ready to go.

Please understand that we are going to do all that we can to ensure our members get something out of season 2021-2022 but we are also offering that if we do not get back to what we know as normal on Greenmount Beach by Christmas all members will be granted free membership for season 2022-2023. That is if our Nippers and our patrolling people are not all back on our beach by Christmas we will give all members free membership to the following year.

Right now we need to all get through this together and I ask that you come forward and renew your membership with the certainty that we are doing all that we can to ensure a good season.

From a patrol point of view. We would have of course liked to have had a patrol roster out to you by now. What you will receive is a perfect world plan for if we are all available from 18/9 and you will also get a second roster with Qld members only in case we need to start the season this way.



If you are a Qld member and not completed your patrol sheet for this year please do so as we need to know what we are working with.

Unfortunately there will be other impacts on the club. Most of our training team and the branch assessors live in NSW so our SRC and Bronze course in the September school holidays is in jeopardy. Please if you are wanting to do this you should have completed an online component by now to register. We will have a window to move some Qld members into courses at other clubs and will run our own when we return to normal.

Please contact the club if you are wanting to do this and based in Qld.

Members thinking of doing their bronze, past actives, reserve actives, based in Qld your club needs you now more than ever. If you are in a position to get involved please also contact the club.

From a training point of view NSW people are not currently allowed to attend group training sessions so our group training for NSW members will be put off until a decision on 10/9 and then we will be ready to go A either all together or B NSW members only sessions in Jack Evans.

Qld members due to 63% of our members not being available we will have to review the training schedule that we released so please wait for future sessions to be released.

Again the worse case scenario is beach and water sessions in Qld for Qld members and beach and water sessions in NSW for NSW members.

Please if you have any concerns or questions reach out to the club.

Some good news though we have filled two of the important roles for the club for next season and I thank these guys for coming forward.

lain Rogers will be our Nipper President and JAC and Andrew Sinclair will be our Yips Coordinator

I look forward to working with these guys.

Nippers are still chasing a Secretary to complete the team if you would like more info on the role please contact lain or myself.


