FROM THE IRB AND TRAINING ROOMS



Hello everyone, Grapevine time again. Boy does time fly.

Well, we got our first Skills Maintenance through in September with about 30 members turning up. Everyone did well, completing the on line theory and practical assessment without difficulty. Our next day is scheduled for 17th October and is a Sunday. Start time is 8am and all certificates of completion for the on line theory must be submitted to the office before, or on the day. If this is not done you will not be permitted to progress.

We commenced our annual School Holiday Bronze/SRC course on the 25th September with 22 candidates signing up, 4 of which are guests from North Burleigh. We were extremely fortunate to have the services of a new trainer/assessor to our team, Amanda Higgerson. Amanda is a relatively new member, transferred from down south but has a wealth of Surf Life Saving knowledge and teaching experience to bring to the training team. Welcome Amanda.

Amanda and I are managing this course as Chris Van Dorn suddenly became unavailable due to work. We were at first concerned about providing adequate water safety. This concern went away with Club Members Darren Free, Hugh and Chuck Norris, Amy Hickling and Ruby Sullivan volunteering to perform the task through the week. We are very grateful to them as the course could not have proceeded without them. Thanks guys.

This training group, once again, are polite, respectful, attentive and fun. They are a real pleasure to train and are a real credit to their parents. This also includes the two boys and two girls from North Burleigh.

Assessment for this group is on Friday 1/10.

The training team are considering running another intense Bronze/SRC course in the December school holidays should there be enough interest. If interested please register with the office so as we can plan for it.

Our training room and storage has recently been transformed with upgraded storage cupboards. The training room is also being fitted with a sliding room divider so that the room can be divided into two self contained training facilities.

IRB STUFF.

All boats and motors started the season well, however motor No2 failed last week with a faulty kill switch.

This is a common problem with Mercury Outboards using cheap kill Switches that let water in , resulting in them rusting up and failing. Should this happen when in use and you want to stop the motor, simply pull the choke lever right out while the engine is idling and the motor will stop. I have spare kill Switches in stock and will do a change over.

The new Zodiac boat seems to be going ok and we are still waiting for our replacement ThunderCat. Has been a long wait.

We have an IRB Driver/Crew course commencing on the 23rd October. Please register your interest with the office as soon as possible so we can put it together.

Surf Life Saving Queensland is committed to the safety of children and young people in our association.

To this end, there are some changes to the required training for members who hold Blue Cards and participate in any of the following activities.

Please note the required date for completion is the 31st of October 2021.

We have been advised by SLSA that they have changed the name of the Child Safeguarding Course and it is now called Child Safe Awareness.

Those who completed the Surfguarding Award have had their award name changed to Child Safe Awareness (as such they don't have to redo the award).

BLUE CARD RENEWALS

Blue card holders will receive a reminder <u>from the office</u> approximately 2 months before their blue card expires and it is important to complete the renewal process as per the instructions provided by Helen ASAP

Note—Members must not patrol without a valid blue card and Point Danger Branch do not process proficiencies and awards for members 18 years & over without a current blue card.

Notice of lodgement is not accepted anymore - no valid card, no participation.
